



## HIGHLIGHT


The number of animals entering shelters continues to slightly increase each year since the pandemic, but is still 16% less than 2019.

Dog intakes represented the majority of this increase from 2021.








Total Outcomes are slightly higher than 2021.



### NATIONAL NON-LIVE OUTCOMES










# HIGHLIGHT

Dog adoption rates remained very consistent throughout the 4 quarters of 2022 with 53% being adopted by year-end.

Cats had higher overall adoption rates than dogs at 64%, but saw much more variability in the rates by quarter.




## HIGHLIGHT

4% more animals entered shelters than left in 2022.

This is up from 2% in 2021 and is the largest gap in the past 4 years.

#### **PBC MONTH-BY-MONTH**




# HIGHLIGHT






### ORG TYPES: SHELTERS

### 4 Year Org Type Population Balance Calculation (PBC)




