As a municipal shelter, we cannot do dog redemptions without UTD rabies/license... is this an issue others find with FRTH?

Emily, we get them out regardless. We microchip them for free at times when they can't afford it because we would rather have that animal go home.

The vets in our community don't give out the chip info or chip number to the finders. Its a huge issue. We have a dog that was scanned by a vet, no finder info given to the company (just the scanning vet's info), vet kept no info and the owner is still looking for the dog a month later.

I also just got my dogs new name tags that have QR codes on them - this lets me add lot of details about their medical and behavioral issues, emergency contacts, veterinarian info, and anything else!
