

OVER 100 COMMUNITY & SHELTER ASSESSMENTS




21 states since 2013

Only difference: latitude and longitude










In just 18 of the shelters analyzed, euthanasia decreased by almost 48,000 animals the first year after the assessment compared to the year before.






OUTCOME FOR CATS: NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE






OUTCOME FOR CATS: WACO, TEXAS







